I am requesting funding for the Dallas/Laclede County Bridge Replacement in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Missouri Department of Transportation located in 105 West Capital Avenue. The funding would be used to support the replacement of a functionally deficient bridge, making safety and operational improvements, and improving modal connectivity by providing a shared use path connection.
