Dear President Trump:

I am writing today to thank you for your continued leadership and your unwavering commitment to restoring law and order in our country. I strongly urge you to keep Kansas City as a 2026 World Cup host city. The world deserves to see the beauty, hospitality, and strength of the American Midwest, and Kansas City has worked diligently to meet every requirement placed before it.
