I am requesting funding for Safe and Reliable Reactor Operations at the University of Missouri in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Curators of the University of Missouri, located at 118 University Hall, Columbia, MO 65211. The funding would be used to acquire critical equipment for the safe and reliable operation of the University of Missouri Research Reactor (MURR), the nation's largest university research reactor and sole domestic producer of key medical radioisotopes used to treat cancer and advance nuclear science research.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the funding will ensure the continued safe and reliable operation of MURR, preventing disruptions in the supply of life-saving isotopes and enabling cutting-edge research in nuclear science, energy, and materials technology. The reactor also supports education and training for the next generation of scientists, engineers, and healthcare professionals.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes described in section 272 of title 15, United States Code.
